

The Center for Independent Living (CIL) has worked diligently to create a national model for it's 42 County New Freedom Transportation Program. Three neighboring Independent Living Centers help to recruit volunteer drivers for CIL's NF program in their service areas shown below.



CIL's New Freedom program now covers 39,774 square miles (60.73% of WI)






WWRTCC Sub committee to coordinate regional trainings and streamline forms

"Mobility Management is the practice of using all available resources, and developing new ones, to improve mobility, increase efficiency and reduce cost."

Wisconsin Department of Transportation coordinated Mobility Management trainings from 2008 through 2010. Due to lack of available funding the DOT could not continue the trainings so we established the Wisconsin Association of Mobility Managers (WAMM). WAMM created extensive trainings and offers also a professional certification process with these valuable trainings. It takes an average of 3 years to become certified. WAMM website; www.wi-mm.org



## **Program Process**

- Client Eligibility
- Cost/Pricing of Services
  - Half of IRS Standard Mileage Allowance
  - Over 5 trips within the month price lowered
  - Veterans Pricing
- Client paperwork
- Computerized Software for Scheduling Trip
- Recruitment of Volunteer Medical Drivers
- Scheduling of Appointments
- Completion of Trip
- Social Trips & Events
