

Why a Transportation Diversity, Equity and Inclusion Initiative?

- NADTC poll findings that African Americans, Hispanic and whites differ in the ways they use transportation.
- Historical and current inequities resulting in disparities in service availability and accessibility.
- By 2050, the U.S. will not have one group that the majority.
- Current Administration's priority

Focus Groups – Three Key Issues Emerged

- Access extended hours, accessible vehicles, crossing jurisdictions, scheduling
- 2. Cost impacts frequency and destination, long distance not available or too expensive, don't like relying on family/friends due to price of gas
- 3. **Treatment** some felt discrimination, some praised drivers, treatment in relation to disability was shared more freely



How Stakeholders are Addressing DEI in Transportation

- Expanding use of listening sessions and offering virtual options
- Preparing for language barriers
- Sharing info with community-based groups serving diverse populations
- Building unique community relationships in rural areas churches, county periodicals, farmer's market, libraries
- Travel training includes using apps and other technologies



Lessons Learned

- Not everyone has the same understanding of transportation DEI.
- Some struggle to recognize diversity in their communities.
- Stakeholders are looking for ways to work on transportation DEI.
- People are less comfortable talking about barriers related to how race, ethnicity or culture impacts transportation access.


What is your organization's involvement in work on transportation DEI?
