Overview

- Planning grant funded through the National Aging and Disability Transportation Center (NADTC)
- Developed a 5+ year Technology and Innovation Strategy, which includes
 - New Mobility
 - Inter-agency coordination and data standards
 - Customer facing technology
 - Strategic partnerships
- Focus on equity and outreach to diverse community members

Process

- Engagement with 130 older adults and people with disabilities
 - 45% BIPOC
 - Over 25% limited English proficiency
- Focus Groups facilitated by Thuy Tu Consulting, in English, Spanish, Vietnamese, and Mandarin.
- Survey translated into Spanish, Vietnamese, Mandarin, and Russian. MFS, IRCO, Impact NW, and other Orgs distributed the survey.
- Interviews with stakeholders, frontline staff, transit agencies, industry leaders, and other professionals.
